



THE FACTORS THAT CAN RUIN WOMEN'S MARRIED LIFE CAN BE EASILY IDENTIFIED THROUGH THE BHRIGU NANDI NADI ASTROLOGICAL METHOD

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Abstract:

Each planet has been assigned certain specific significations (karakatva). These karaka planets create yogas (planetary combinations) based on the influence or relationship of the planets by which they are aspected. The results of these yogas manifest during the transit periods of their respective karaka planets.

Key Words: The factors That Can Ruin Women's Married Life Can Be Easily Identified through the Bhrigu Nandi Nadi Astrological Method.

Rules of Nadi:

The general rule is that a planet gives good results when it is placed in its exaltation house, own house, or friendly house, and gives bad results when it is in its debilitation house or enemy house. Unlike traditional astrology, planets are not considered as natural malefics or natural benefics. Instead, the auspicious and inauspicious results given by planets are analyzed only from the perspective of planetary friendships and enmities.

For example:

Sun: Venus, Saturn, Rahu, Ketu

Moon: Mercury, Venus, Saturn, Rahu, Ketu

Mars: Mercury, Saturn, Rahu

Mercury: Moon, Mars, Jupiter, Ketu

Jupiter: Mercury, Venus

Venus: Sun, Moon, Jupiter

Saturn: Sun, Moon, Ketu, Mars

Rahu: Sun, Moon, Mercury, Saturn

Ketu: Sun, Moon, Mercury, Saturn

In the zodiac circle, the 5th and 9th signs from any given sign indicate the same direction. Similarly, the 3rd, 7th, and 11th signs from any sign will be in the opposite direction. This can be easily understood through the zodiac chart grid. When a planet has friendly planets in the same sign where it is placed, or in the 5th and 9th signs from it (planets in the same direction), or in the 3rd, 7th, and 11th signs (planets in the opposite direction), it will give beneficial results. If enemy planets are present in these positions, it will give harmful results. According to Nadi astrology rules, the planets in the same direction (1-5-9) and the planets in signs in the opposite direction (3-7-11) should be considered as being in the same straight line when predicting results. For example, if 1-5-9 is the north direction, then 3-7-11 becomes the south direction.

Directions of the Signs:

Aries, Leo, Sagittarius - East

Taurus, Virgo, Capricorn - South

Gemini, Libra, Aquarius - West

Cancer, Scorpio, Pisces - North

According to Jaimini Sutras, a planet aspects 30 degrees before and after it. In accordance with this principle, if friendly planets are placed in the houses before and after the house where a planet is located - that is, in the 2nd or 12th houses - it will give good results, and if enemy planets are there, it will give bad results.

If an enemy planet is placed in the 2nd or 12th house, then a planet, no matter how strong it may be, will neither give beneficial results nor cause harm. Therefore, in Nadi astrology, it is necessary to analyze the planets in the 2nd and 12th signs from the sign where the karaka planet is placed. The results vary depending on these planets.

- A planet will give the results of the significations (karakatva) of the planets that are conjoined with it and the planets that aspect it.
- A planet will give results according to the significations (karakatva) of the sign in which it is placed.
- To know what events will occur in a person's lifetime, one must examine planetary combinations (graha cherkai), and to know when they will occur, one must look at transits (gocharas).
- If any planet is placed alone in a sign without receiving the aspect of any other planet, that planet will give the significations (karakatva) of the lord of the sign in which it is positioned.
- If a planet is placed alone, with no planets in the 1-5-9, 3-7-11, and 2-12 positions from it, and receives no aspect from any planet, but that planet is in mutual exchange (parivartana) with another planet, it will give extraordinary beneficial results.

- For Rahu and Ketu, they only have the aspects of planets conjoined with them in the same sign and the aspect of the 12th house. This is because they travel in the opposite direction. For them, the 12th house becomes the 2nd house.
- When a debilitated planet in a sign is in mutual exchange (parivartana) with the lord of that sign, the planet gets cancellation of debilitation (neecha bhanga). After the exchange, that planet gives auspicious or inauspicious results according to the significations of friendly or enemy planets.
- When a debilitated planet receives aspects from planets placed in 1-5-9, 3-7-11, or 2-12 positions, the debilitation gets cancelled. That is, neecha bhanga (cancellation of debilitation) occurs. It gives auspicious or inauspicious results depending on the nature of the aspecting planets. If they are friendly planets, they give good results, and if they are enemy planets, they give bad results.
- When a planet is placed very close to the Sun, that is, within one nakshatra pada (one pada = 3.20 degrees), it becomes combust (astangam). A combust planet loses its strength and does not give good results.
- If a combust planet is in mutual exchange (parivartana) with another planet, it will give very good results.
- When a combust planet is conjoined with a friendly planet, or receives the aspect of a friendly planet, that planet will give good results. At the same time, if it has connection with an enemy planet, it will give bad results.
- When the Sun and Venus are in the same nakshatra pada, Venus becomes combust, causing the native (male or female) to become infertile / sterile. When Venus is in mutual exchange (parivartana) with Mercury or Jupiter, the infertility is removed.
- Since a retrograde planet aspects half of the sign behind it, its results will depend on the sign that is behind it.
- If a friendly planet is retrograde in the 2nd house from where a planet is placed, it will give good results, and if it is an enemy planet, it will give bad results.
- Similarly, if an enemy planet is in retrograde position in the 12th house from where a planet is placed, that planet will give good results.
- When a planet is in retrograde, if a friendly planet is in the 12th house from it, it will give good results, and if an enemy planet is there, it will give bad results.
- If a debilitated or exalted planet is retrograde, and an enemy planet is positioned in the 12th house from it, that planet will give contrary/opposite results.
- A planet acquires the significations (karakatva) of the planets by which it is aspected.
- Since Nadi system astrology derives results based on the significations of planets and the significations of signs, the ascendant (lagna) is not required. Only the zodiac chart (rashi katta) is sufficient. Divisional charts (varga chakras) are also not analyzed. It is one of the simplest methods for deriving results.

Relationships in Nadi System:

Sun - Father, Son

Moon - Mother, Mother-in-law, Elder sister, Female progeny, Maternal aunt/paternal aunt, Maternal uncle's wife

Mars - Brother, 2nd younger brother, Husband (for females), Marriage significator for women

Mercury - Maternal uncle, 3rd younger brother/younger sister, Male/female friends, Boyfriend, Girlfriend, Friend

Jupiter - Male native (Jeeva karaka), Childbirth

Venus - Female native, Daughter, Daughter-in-law, Wife, 2nd younger sister, House, Vehicles, Economy/Finance

Saturn - First elder brother, Livelihood significator

Rahu - Paternal grandfather

Ketu - Maternal grandfather

Separation or Marriage Dissolution between Spouses:

Rule:

In a woman's horoscope, the planet signifying the female native is Venus. The planet signifying the husband is Mars. If Venus is on one side of the Rahu-Ketu axis and Mars is on the other side, separation will occur. Or the married life will not be happy.

In the above-mentioned horoscope, since Venus is on one side of the Rahu-Ketu axis and Mars is on the other side, even though the lady had a love marriage, their life did not prosper.

In this woman's horoscope, since Venus is positioned on one side of the Rahu-Ketu axis and Mars is on the other side, the native's life was adversely affected. "Therefore, the legal divorce occurred in 2020."

"In the above horoscope, the planet representing the native (female) is Venus, and Mars represents the husband - Rahu-Ketu are on the opposite side of the axis. This caused disruption in married life."

"In the above horoscope, Venus is positioned on one side of the Rahu-Ketu axis and Mars, which represents the husband, is positioned on the other side. Therefore, a situation arose for divorce and she obtained a legal divorce."

In the above woman's horoscope, Venus is on one side, and Mars is on the other side of the Rahu-Ketu axis. Therefore, the native (female) obtained a legal divorce.

Conclusion:

In a woman's horoscope, since the native is represented by Venus and the husband by Mars, if the Rahu-Ketu axis occurs between them, divorce takes place. Or the married life becomes a very struggling one.
